Hi, my name is Philip Faustin.

I have been involved with Operation Rescue Colorado since 1989.

I was born prolife. At birth, I was given up for adoption so I have always been grateful I am a prolife activist because I know how that my mother didn't kill me. Thankfully, I haven't had situations in my life that would push me to reject the awareness we are all born with that abortion is wrong. A couple of years ago I found my birth mother and sent her a letter of gratitude.

My first involvement in the pro-life movement was in 1982 with a group called Christian Research Associates. I produced their newsletter back in the day when I was given strips of text that I had to wax to sheets of paper. That was the origin of cut and paste. The layout was then photographed, etched onto a metal plate and printed. After a couple of years, I was replaced by desktop publishing.

> In 1989, I was involved in the beginning of Operation Rescue Colorado. For a couple of years we spent a lot of time blocking the doors of abortion clinics, getting arrested and spending time in court and in iail. Sometimes we were arrested for things we didn't do.

abortion ruins lives.

Through the years, we have had continuous pickets and sidewalk counseling at abortion clinics and on occasion picketed abortionist's homes and hospitals with abortionists on staff. A clinic we currently picket does abortions through 5 months.

In the early years, I spent a lot of time digging through the trash of a place we picketed. One Saturday morning I found the foot of a baby. It was almost a halfinch long and perfectly formed. Over the course of several months, I found close to a hundred bodies. Sometimes we found the mother's medical information that the abortionist had trashed alongside the bodies of their children.

In 1997, we started displaying an Abortion Kills Children banner on the overpass at 6th Avenue and Perry Street. That started an 8-year legal battle with the City of Denver. The argument was that the banner was distracting to drivers. It seemed the city was not aware that there are signs and billboards along most busy streets in Denver. We prevailed in court after court while the City changed their story each time. Finally, in 2005 Denver found 2 out of 3 sympathetic judges on a panel from the 10th Circuit and won. Soon after, Denver outlawed banners on overpasses. For two years after that, we displayed the banner on the corner of 6th Avenue and Lincoln Street in Denver.

In 1997, we started going to local high schools in the spring and fall where we pass out literature to the students on the sidewalks around the school. Generally we are well received by the students but fought against by many teachers and administrators.

In everything we have done through the years, Operation Rescue has been committed to non-violence against people and property.

We view our activism as one facet of the prolife movement; very important but not the only thing needed.
